### Overnight Road Closures - 16th-18th May

There will be overnight closures of Stocklake Link Road (urban) from Monday 16th May to Wednesday 18th May (inclusive) for planing (removing the existing surfacing) and resurfacing works. The closures will be in place from 19.00hrs - 06.00hrs. The area between Oakfield Road junction and the Fire Station needs to be closed to traffic for health and safety reasons to ensure the protection of the workforce who will be working in the carriageway and also the public. Unfortunately this cannot be done during the day due to access requirements, the traffic flows on the road, and the width of the road. Residents will be able to access their properties despite the road closure but will need to follow the diversions. Pedestrians will also have access.
