

# A413 Sustainable Travel Scheme

## Bulletin #01 1st July 2016

Dear Residents and Businesses,

Welcome to the first bulletin of the A413 Sustainable Travel Scheme (STS) and plan for its construction. This bulletin and further updates will provide performance and progress of the A413 STS construction programme in the coming weeks and months all the way through to completion.

### Introduction

The scheme will create a 9km shared cycle and footway corridor that interconnects the town centres of Buckingham and Winslow. This scheme will also upgrade three existing bus stops in Buckingham with real-time passenger information and Wi-Fi accessibility.

The aim of the scheme is to promote use of pedestrian, cycle and bus routes to both town centres, the planned [East-West Rail](#) train station at Winslow, as well as other local destinations along the A413 corridor.

Construction of the scheme commences on the 4th July 2016 for a duration of approximately 6 months.

### Delivery Plan

The construction works will be carried out in sections along the 9km A413 corridor. Descriptions for each section and when they will be constructed will be detailed on the project website.

- Construction will take place only on weekdays (Monday to Friday)
- Weekday working hours start from 9am to 3pm daily (with the exception of Bank Holidays)
- Two teams of the contractors will be working on the construction of the scheme at the same time to help speed up completion of the works.

It is likely the Christmas (no works) embargo will not affect the scheme delivery programme. Further details will be provided nearer to this time with information updates provided on the project website.

The following sections of footway work are due to commence shortly as follows:

- London Road, Buckingham. From Total Garage to Needlepin Way are scheduled to commence on the 4th July 2016 and it is estimated that they will take 7 days to complete.
- Winslow Road, Padbury. From Folly Inn to Thornborough turn are scheduled to commence on the 4th July 2016 and it is estimated that they will take 54 days to complete.

## Delivery Plan (continued)

- Buckingham Road, Winslow. From Furze Lane to Hanover Farm are scheduled to commence on the 13th July 2016 and it is estimated that they will take 35 days to complete.

The construction works will predominately take place on the northern kerb line of the A413, although lane closures may be necessary to allow sufficient safety zones for contractors to carry out the works.

Information signs will be erected on site prior to commencement of works at various sections along the A413 corridor, giving actual dates and durations. If for any reasons the construction works are delayed we will inform you via our regular email bulletin, advance information signs on site and updates on the project website.

For sections where lane closures are implemented it can be expected that temporary traffic lights will be used where appropriate to ensure two-way controlled traffic operations are maintained during the construction period. **Every effort is being deployed to ensure congestion on the A413 is kept to a minimum.**
